Our plan provides important information about our revised school year calendar, student learning options, and many aspects related to health, safety, and school operations. As mentioned in the email to parents last week, we are asking that you select a learning option for your student(s) by Monday, July 20. If you are selecting the Remote or Blended learning option, you are required to complete a short online application. There is no need to complete the application if you are choosing the Traditional learning option. Families who do not complete the application for Remote or Blended learning will automatically be opted-in to the Traditional learning option. If you are choosing the Traditional learning option, we ask that you complete a short survey to assist in our planning efforts.
