



Details on Learning Options

for the 2020-2021 school year

Traditional Students on Staggered Schedule

Students will attend face-to-face instruction in the traditional classroom setting two days each week based on last name.

- **Students with last names beginning with A - L: (Green Group)**
 - Monday and Tuesday: Attend traditional classes at school.
 - Wednesday, Thursday, Friday: Students will complete remote learning assignments on the days they are not physically in the classroom. All content for remote instruction will consist of videos, lessons, and learning games aligned to the Alabama Course of Study Standards and designed for ongoing learning. Work may consist of the following:
 - Edgenuity Courseware for grades 6-12
 - Odysseyware for grades 3-5
 - Teacher created content for grades K-12
 - Students are expected to work on remote learning assignments on the days they are not physically in buildings.
 - Assignments will be graded and applicable credits granted.
- **Students with last names beginning with M - Z: (Gold Group)**
 - Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday: Students will complete remote learning assignments on the days they are not physically in the classroom. All content for remote instruction will consist of videos, lessons, and learning games aligned to the Alabama Course of Study Standards and designed for ongoing learning. Work may consist of the following:
 - Edgenuity Courseware for grades 6-12
 - Odysseyware for grades 3-5
 - teacher created content for K-12.
 - Thursday and Friday: Attend traditional classes at school.
 - Students are expected to work on remote learning assignments on the days they are not physically in buildings.
 - Assignments will be graded and applicable credits granted.
- Students working remotely will be able to access content at the time of their choosing. Teachers will assign daily lessons, and students are expected to complete work each day. Since students work at differing speeds, no set times for learning will be given.
- Progress reports will be uploaded to students' Google Classrooms every three weeks.
- Students will receive instruction on accessing virtual content on their first in-person day of school.
- Teachers will have office hours on Wednesdays and will have a weekly Google Meet.
